

Identity Cards

Identity Cards is a simple introduction/ice breaker game to get students introduced to each other. This activity can be used with young learners, teens and adults.

Aim: To practice speaking, introducing another student and basic writing

Level: Lower Intermediate and above

Time: 10 - 30 minutes

Method

- 1. Put students into pairs and each student is given a blank identity card.
- 2. In pairs, students interview each other and fill in the blanks in their identity cards.
- 3. After, each student introduces their partner using the cards to help them.

Alternative Ideas:

- Get students to memorise the information on the cards and then tell the other students about their partner.
- Get students to draw a picture of their partner and later hang them in the classroom.
